**LICENCE FOR LIVESTOCK FARM/~~ABATTOIR~~/MEAT PROCESSING  
FACTORY/~~FEED MILL~~\***  
(Section 42/48/60/69\*)

It is hereby certified that *Satoyama Farm & Contruction Sdn. Bhd* of *Ground Floor, Lot 1445 (SL16), Riveria Phase 5, Kuching Samarahan Eksperssway, 94300 Kota Samarahan* is licensed to carry out livestock farming at *Lot 330 & Lot 546, Block 16, Melikin Land District, Jalan Serian-Sri Aman, 94700 Serian* and breed, rear, keep or treat the following type(s) of livestock *Chicken (Broiler)* only at the said livestock farm, subject to the following conditions and restrictions:

- (i) The livestock farm is situated on land or a locality which is suitable for the rearing of the type of livestock to which the licence relates.
- (ii) Having regard to the standing livestock population in that livestock farm, the facilities provided for the treatment and disposal of waste in that livestock farm would not result in the pollution of the areas in the vicinity of the livestock farm or any watercourse.
- (iii) There are adequate facilities and precautions taken in the livestock farm to prevent or control the spread of infections or contagious diseases amongst the livestock.
- (iv) The facilities for the treatment of waste in the livestock farm are capable of meeting the standard prescribed in the Livestock Farming Rules 2003.
- (v) The farm should be operated and managed in accordance with the provisions of the VPH Ordinance, 1999.

### **Other Conditions**

1. Direct discharges of poultry waste into rivers, streams, ponds or lakes etc. are totally prohibited.
2. Infestation of flies should be kept to a minimum by the use of larvicide, lime powder and insecticide. Faeces should be kept dry and treated appropriately to reduce odour and flies.
3. Bird carcasses and other wastes are to be disposed of properly, either by burying, burning in incinerators.
4. If the bird carcasses are intended for the feeding fish it should be cooked before feeding.
5. Suitable trees or plants should be planted around the farm to control malodour and act as buffer zone.
6. This Licence is revocable under Section 44 Part V of Veterinary Public Health Ordinance, 1999 and rules Section 102 should there be non-compliance's to any of the condition of this licence.
7. There should be no increase of stock from the present population without State Veterinary Authority's approval.
8. The Licensee is required to submit quarterly information in the form attached to the nearest Veterinary Office.
9. Annual renewal of Licence should be made 2 months before the expiry date, failing which a penalty of RM50 will be imposed.
10. Application received on or after expiry date of the licence, a RM100 penalty will be imposed.
11. Penalty must be paid before the renewal application is to be processed.
12. Operating livestock farm without valid livestock licence is an offence under Section 42 (2) of the Veterinary Public Health Ordinance, 1999 and is liable to a fine not exceeding five thousand ringgit or to imprisonment not exceeding two years or to both such fine and imprisonment.
13. In the event that this farming license is not renewed for three (3) consecutive years, the licensee is deemed to have stopped farming. Issuance of **new** farming licence is subjected to prior approvals from the Land and Survey Department and the Natural Resources Environment Board.

### **Display of Licence**

1. This licence is to be displayed at a conspicuous place on the Livestock farm concerned. Failure to do so and shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding five hundred ringgit (Section 45, The Veterinary Public Health Ordinance 1999).
